Students will have a chance to learn about engineering technologies in the vicinity of Osnabrück, and travel to Brussels, Berlin and Amsterdam.

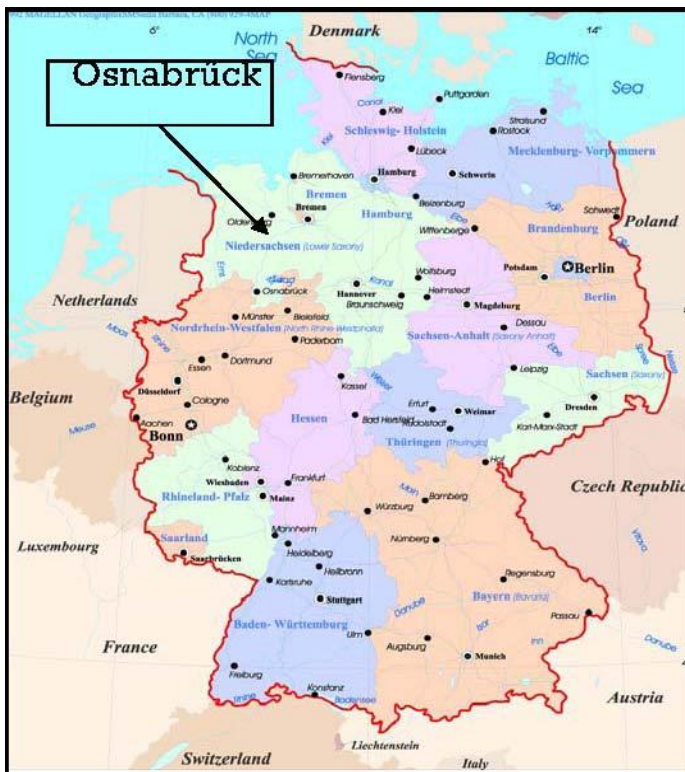

## UF in Osnabrück

The UF in Osnabrück program is designed for students with an interest in engineering. The program will also offer an opportunity for two day trips such as Amsterdam, Berlin and Brussels. Other planned excursions as listed below:

- Visit to a manufacturer of solar panels
- Visit to the Institute for Food Technology
- Visit to a steel manufacturer
- Visit to Transrapid, magnetic levitation train
- Visit to Grimme and a company which produces harvester and tillage equipment
- Visit to Renewable Center using Biomass
- Visit a mile-deep coal mining operation
- Visit to peat bog



## Academic Credits

As this is a UF program, with prior approval credits taken can satisfy major, minor, and university requirements. UF credit will be earned with courses taught by local instructors at the FH-University of Applied Sciences.

### **FEES DUE UPON APPLICATION:**

A \$250 deposit toward the total cost of the program is required at the time of application, of which \$50 is non-refundable. The remaining fees are due no later than 30 days prior to departure. Students receiving financial aid may defer payment for up to 60 days after departure.

### ***Not Included in the program fees:***

Round-trip airfare, additional personal travel and personal expenses.

Major medical health insurance coverage while outside of the United States is **MANDATORY** for all UF students. Verification of major medical health insurance coverage which meets UF standards is required.

## Financial Aid

University of Florida students needing financial aid should apply through UF Student Financial Affairs (SFA). Non-UF students needing financial aid must apply to their home institutions.

## Scholarships

Partial scholarships for UF students are available on a competitive basis through the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, the Honors program, as well as the International Center.

## Housing

The program offers lodging in a newly renovated guesthouse. The guesthouse is an historical building part of which is depicted in the photograph below. The guesthouse is located on the campus of the FH-University of Applied Sciences. Students will share double rooms and be responsible for all meals.
